Rule of 85 Request

An Abbeville Rotary Club Rotarian is exempt from attendance requirements if:

- 1. The aggregate of the member's years of age and years of membership in one or more Rotary clubs is 85 years or more
- 2. The member has notified the club secretary in writing of the member's desire to be excused from attendance
- 3. And the board has approved.

Article 9 Attendance, Section 3 — Excused Absences. A member's absence shall be excused if (b) the aggregate of the member's years of age and years of membership in one or more (Rotary) clubs is 85 years or more and the member has notified the club secretary in writing of the member's desire to be excused from attendance and the board has approved.

The "Rule of 85" does not exempt a member from payment of dues.

Rule of 85 members are still considered active members and are highly encourage to continue in attendance at regular meetings and community service events.
